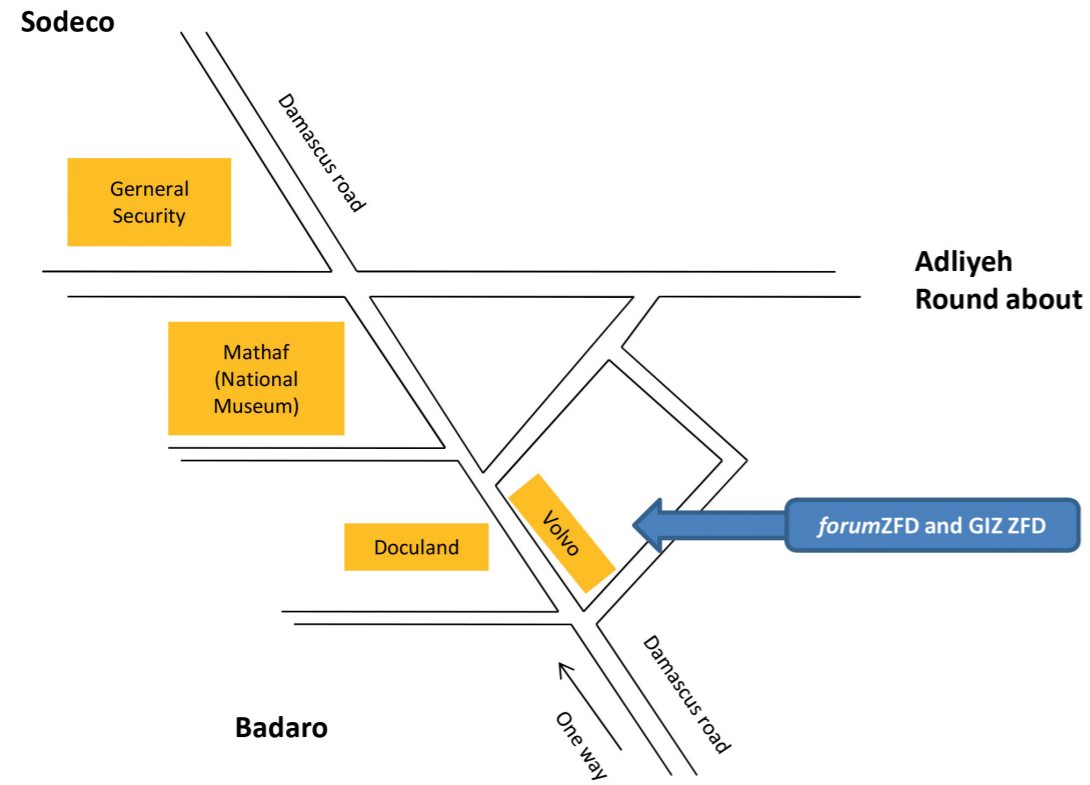

The **Civil Peace Service (CPS)** supports projects aimed at non-violent conflict resolutions in various countries worldwide.

It second experts to assist local partner organisations. Its objectives are the prevention of violent conflicts, the reduction of violence, and the long-term securing of peace.

Nine German development and peace organisations have joined up to form the **Civil Peace Service Consortium**. Members of the consortium include non-governmental as well as governmental agencies.

The programme is financed by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

GIZ

GIZ is a federally-owned enterprise that supports the German government in achieving its objectives in the field of international cooperation for sustainable development.

Internationally, it is the aim of the **GIZ CPS** to contribute towards preventing violent conflicts from erupting, dealing with conflicts without resorting to violence, and building structures and institutions that help secure a long-term peace.

GIZ advisors and local staff work in close partnership with local NGOs in order to link committed stakeholders through systematic exchange, to advise on organizational development and to create dialogue across conflict lines.

forumZFD

Forum Civil Peace Service (forumZFD) was established in 1996 as a German NGO by individuals and organizations active in the peace movement. **forumZFD** is lobbying for an alternative to military interventions and violence.

A world that resolves conflicts without violence is the vision of **forumZFD**.

To foster a culture of non-violence, **forumZFD** trains experts and supports and implements projects in Germany, the Western Balkans, the Philippines and the Middle East.

The overall approach is to strengthen networks and communication structures as well as to support 'Actors of Change', like multipliers in civil society and local structures.

In Lebanon the Civil Peace Service (CPS) is represented by GIZ and the forumZFD.
